The early history of the Ms. is not known, but we learn from a note on the fly-leaf at the beginning of the book that it was given to Sir Hans Sloane by Sir Paul Methuen. It came into the possession of the nation when the British Museum was founded by the purchase of Sloane s Collections. The Manuscript is mentioned by Noble in his History of the College of Arms, who says, He (Smith) wrote a description of this kingdom; embellishing it with drawings of its chief towns (p. 218). It may seem strange to some that a work containing carefully drawn views of London, Cambridge, Bristol, Bath, c., made in Elizabeth s reign, should not have attracted notice, but nothing will surprise those who know what treasures lie hidden in the MS. collections...
